Interlingual Live Subtitling for Access ([ILSA](#)) is a three-year (September 2017-August 2020) project co-financed by the European Union under the Erasmus+ Programme, Key Action 2 - Cooperation for Innovation and the Exchange of Good Practices, KA203 - Strategic Partnerships for Higher Education (Reference Number 2017-1-ES01-KA203-037948).

As a strategic partnership promoting open and innovative practices in the digital era, ILSA has identified the skills and profile of a new type of speech-to-text interpreter, the interlingual respeaker (or transpeaker). ILSA has developed, tested and validated the first training course on interlingual resparking (transpeaking) and provide guidelines for the implementation of this discipline in three real-life scenarios, namely TV, political/social settings and the classroom.
